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Exploring Torrin, Sconser and Strathaird on Skye

A car park at the foot of Blà Bheinn enables people to access the path to the mountain. There is further parking towards Elgol on the B8083, just beyond Strathaird. From here you can access the south ridge of Blà Bheinn, Camasunary, Loch Coruisk, Sligachan and the Black Cuillin.

The village of Elgol provides another starting point where you can follow the coastal path west through Glen Scaladal, an old Viking settlement and area of high geological interest.

In Sconser, there's a path that goes south past Marsco to Camasunary with a deviation that branches southwest at Ruadh Stac to take you over Druim Hain to Loch Coruisk.
